

# Explanation of Titles

## Jedi Seeker

A Jedi Seeker is a student who is currently taking the Jedi Seeker Program, either in the form of Zoom or the solo-program on the IJF website.

## Seeker Requirements to Candidacy-

- Must be a Registered Member of the International Jedi Federation.

## Jedi Apprentice

A Jedi Apprentice is a student who has graduated from the Jedi Seeker Program and sought a one-on-one apprenticeship with a Jedi Mentor.

## Apprentice Requirements to Candidacy-

- Must complete the Jedi Seeker's Program.

## Jedi Adept Definition

A Jedi Adept is a Jedi who has demonstrated themselves to embody the principles of the Jedi Compass, and seek to advance themselves in the Jedi Arts for a specific life mission dedicated to their personal offline community. Jedi Adepts are not afforded an opportunity to take on Apprentices or become Chapter Leaders.

## Adept Requirements to Candidacy-

- Must complete the Jedi Seeker's Program, and an apprenticeship.

## Adept Trials-

- Undergo a Labyrinth of Trials
- Pass a Practical Exam
- Go Through a Ceremony of Dedication to the Jedi Path

## Adept Privileges (beyond basic membership):

- May join any Discipline open to Adepts
- May serve on any committee

## Jedi Knight Definition

A Jedi Knight is a Jedi who has demonstrated themselves to embody the principles of the Jedi Compass, and seek to advance themselves in the Jedi Arts in service of International Jedi Federation (IJF). Jedi Knights may do this by becoming Chapter Leaders, Jedi Educators, Jedi Mentors, Facilitating discussions in approved IJF social spaces/events, creating content for IJF spaces, etc.

## Knight Requirements to Candidacy-

- Must complete the Jedi Seeker's Program, and an apprenticeship.

\*\* Exceptions exists for Knighthood Transfer Assessments

## Knight Trials-

- Two Letters of Recommendation (one must be their Mentor)
- Undergo a Labyrinth of Trials
- Pass a Practical Exam
- Undergo a Background Check
- Sit before a Knighting Panel

## Knight Privileges (beyond basic membership):

- May join any Discipline (Mystic, Sage, etc)
- May serve on any committee
- May run a Jedi Chapter
- May have apprenticeships
- May become an Educator for any Discipline they are certified to (Mystic, Sage, etc).
- May serve on the Jedi Council

**Adept Scholar Definition**

Adept Scholars are Jedi Adepts who have dedicated their lives to a particular service to their offline community (either as a volunteer or in their career) for a minimum of 3 years of their time as a Jedi Adept, and have used the Jedi Compass to advance this service.

**Adept Scholar Requirements to Candidacy:**

- Must be a Jedi Adept in good standing, with a minimum of 7 years as an Adept/Knight.
- Must have a minimum of 3 years in the service that they wish to use as an example of their mastery Duty to All plus a minimum of 2 parts of the Jedi Compass. A service may be, but not limited to, a volunteer project, an active project that advances their place of work, or a professional career that services their community (medical, first responder, military, etc).
- Submit a 25-page, 12pt font, double-spaced paper on a document with no more than 1 inch margins, detailing how they have used the Jedi Compass to improve their service to their community/workplace. The Adept must first discuss the basis of their thesis for approval with the Council of Knowledge.

**Adept Scholar Trials-**

- After approval for Adept Scholar Candidacy, the council will review the candidate for approval to undergo the Master Labyrinth Trials. Once approved by the Jedi Council, their thesis will be added to the Temple Archives.

**Jedi Master Definition**

Jedi Masters are Jedi Knights who have added to the body of education in one of the order's disciplines (Mystic, Sage, etc) after a minimum of 7 years of service to the International Jedi Federation.

**Jedi Master Requirements to Candidacy:**

- Must be a Jedi Knight in good standing, with a minimum of 7 years consistently as a Jedi Knight.
- Must submit a body of work in accordance with the specifications of the department (Mystic, Sage, etc) overseeing their discipline to the Director of the Department and Council of Knowledge.

**Jedi Master Trials-**

- After approval for Jedi Master Candidacy, the council will review the candidate for approval to undergo the Master Labyrinth Trials. Once approved by the Jedi Council, their body of work will be added to the Temple Archives for the department which they have become a master of.
